We recently surveyed our subscribers on their Sonoma Valley recommendations for wineries, accommodations and activities and below are their responses (in order of popularity).

Best winery for a picnic:

Over 10% recommend Chateau St. Jean (famous for their red wine Cinq Cepages), then 4% prefer Bartholomew Park, Benziger and Buena Vista followed by Ferrari Carano, Rochioli and Viansa.

Best value lunch:

Over 10% voted for Oakville Grocery in Healdsburg (sister grocery store in Oakville) with the Dry Creek General Store in second and Café Citti rounding out the popular opinion.

Best lunch (regardless of price):

The Girl and the Fig garnered 12% of the vote followed by Chateau Souverain and Oakville Grocery then Dry Creek Kitchen.

Best value dinner:

The Girl and the Fig garnered 7% here with Café La Haye and Bistro Ralph receiving 5% each.

Best dinner (regardless of price):

Over 11% voted for Cyrus with 9% voting for The Girl and the Fig followed by Dry Creek Kitchen, Café La Haye and Bistro Ralph.

Best romantic restaurant:

Over 14% of you voted for John Ash & Co. with Cyrus, Dry Creek Kitchen and Farmhouse Inn and Restaurant rounding out the recommendations.

Best bar to grab a cocktail and relax:

Dry Creek Kitchen came in first with 9% followed by Cyrus, The Girl and the Fig and Willi's Wine Bar.

Best bakery and/or breakfast:

Downtown Bakery garnered 8% of the vote followed by Costeaux Bakery & Café and Artisan Bakery then Basque Bakery.

Best winery for the first time Sonoma Valley visitor:

Over 14% of you voted for Chateau St. Jean followed by Benziger, Ferrari-Carano and Kendall-Jackson.

Best winery tour and/or wine educational event:

Over 18% of you voted for Benziger followed by Chateau St. Jean, Kenwood and Kunde...

Best winery for the advanced visitor (unknown winery gem):

Gems include A. Rafanelli, Kosta-Browne, Arrowood and Martinelli.

Best winery to visit when you have non-drinkers in your group:

Ferrari-Carano came in first with 10% followed by Chateau St. Jean, Viansa and Kenwood.

Best new winery to visit (less than two years old):

Kosta-Browne and Mayo Family were the only wineries mentioned with frequency.

Winery that offers most variety of wines to taste:

Over 11% voted for Chateau St. Jean followed by Kenwood, Martinelli, Mayo Family, David Coffaro and Ferrari-Carano.

Best small winery where you will meet the winemaker and/or owner:

Over 8% voted for Kosta-Browne followed by Kaz, Rafanelli, Schug, Siduri and David Caffaro.

Best bed and breakfast on a budget:

Only two mentions received a sizeable number of votes; Trojan Horse Inn and Healdsburg Inn..

Best bed and breakfast (regardless of price):

Only three mentions received a sizeable number of votes; Glenn Ellen Inn, Madrona Manor and Trojan Horse Inn.

Best hotel/motel:

Over 15% voted for Hotel Healdsburg followed by Sonoma Mission Inn and Spa, MacArthur Place and Vintners Inn.

Best Spa in the Sonoma Valley:

Over 38% voted for Sonoma Mission Inn and Spa followed by Kenwood Inn and Spa.

Best activity when you aren't tasting wine, eating, golfing, shopping or visiting a spa in the Sonoma Valley: Over 14% voted for hiking followed by biking.
